Tips for a successful S&E experience!

- Arrive EARLY, especially if it is out of town! 30 minutes before your performance is always a good rule of thumb.
- Bring your:
 - Instrument
 - Bow
 - Shoulder rest/rock stop
 - Music stand (they might not have any in the warm up area)
- MUSIC REQUIREMENTS:
 - One <u>ORIGINAL</u> copy of the music for your stand WITH THE MEASURES NUMBERED
 - One <u>ORIGINAL</u> copy of the music for your judge WITH THE MEASURES NUMBERED
 - If your piece is public domain (printed off of IMSLP), please include the information page that states that it is Public Domain
 - If your piece is a purchase ePrint/eCopy, print and bring a copy of your receipt for proof of purchase
- Dress professionally in your orchestra uniform or something similar. This is a performance, even if it is not like our orchestra concerts, so judges are expecting professional uniforms.
- Introduce yourself, your pianist (Mr. Tim Hanes) and your piece prior to performing, and then THANK THE JUDGE at the end of your time with them.
- Bring water and snacks
- Please use Remind to message me with concerns or questions on the day of the event.
- Have a successful performance!
